

Admissions Process at NIET Business School

PGDM Admissions 2026–28

At NIET Business School, we believe that students are our core stakeholders and future business leaders. Our admission process is designed to identify committed, high-potential candidates with academic consistency, leadership potential, and a strong inclination towards management education.

The selection process is comprehensive and evaluates candidates on multiple dimensions including academic performance, aptitude, communication skills, and managerial potential.

Eligibility Criteria

Candidates seeking admission to the PGDM Program at NIET Business School must fulfill the following eligibility requirements:

Academic Requirements

1. A Bachelor's Degree in any discipline from a recognized university
2. Minimum 50% marks for General Category
3. Minimum 45% marks for SC/ST Category
4. Final year students may also apply (subject to submission of final marksheet by 30th September of admission year)
5. Academic performance in Class X, XII and Graduation will be considered
6. Eligibility norms will be followed as per the latest AICTE guidelines

Entrance Exam Requirement

Applicants appeared in any of the following national level entrance examinations will be given preference:

1. CAT
2. MAT
3. XAT
4. CMAT
5. ATMA (if applicable)

Admission Process

The admission process at NIET Business School consists of the following stages:

Step 1: Application Submission

Candidates can apply through:

- Online Application Form

Candidates are required to fill all details carefully and upload necessary documents to proceed to the next stage.

Step 2: Application Screening

Applications are screened by the Admission Panel based on:

1. Academic consistency
2. Academic diversity
3. Work experience (if any)
4. Extra-curricular achievements

Shortlisted candidates are invited for further selection rounds.

Step 4: Group Discussion (GD) & Personal Interview (PI)

Shortlisted candidates will be invited for Group Discussion. The GD round assesses:

1. Communication Skills
2. Teamwork
3. Analytical Thinking
4. Leadership Skills
5. Problem Solving Ability

Candidates qualifying GD will appear for Personal Interview. The interview panel evaluates:

1. Career Vision
2. Academic Knowledge
3. General Awareness
4. Communication Skills
5. Learning Orientation

PI Evaluation Parameters (50 Marks)

- Vision for Future – 10 Marks
- Academic Knowledge – 10 Marks
- General Awareness – 10 Marks
- Communication – 10 Marks
- Learning Orientation – 10 Marks

Final Selection Criteria

The final selection of candidates is based on overall performance in:

- Academic Record
- Entrance Exam Score
- Group Discussion
- Personal Interview
- Work Experience (if any)

Selected candidates will receive admission offer letters.

Scholarship Scheme

NIET Business School offers merit-based scholarships to encourage academic excellence and support deserving candidates.

Scholarship Eligibility Criteria

Students must:

- Maintain minimum 75% marks throughout the program
- Maintain minimum 75% attendance
- Maintain discipline and academic conduct

Exam Based Scholarships

- MAT
 - Score 501-600 : 20,000.00 Rs.
 - Score 601-700 : 25,000.00 Rs.
 - Score 701 & above : 30,000.00 Rs.
- CAT/XAT
 - Percentile 51-60 : 25,000.00 Rs.
 - Percentile 61-70 : 30,000.00 Rs.
 - Percentile above 71 : 35,000.00 Rs.
- CMAT
 - Rank 10,001—20,000 : 20,000.00 Rs.
 - Rank 01,001— 10,000 : 25,000.00 Rs.
 - Rank 01— 4,000 : 30,000.00 Rs.

Dr. O.P Agarwal Academic Excellence Scholarship

- Male candidates who secure 65% or above in 10th, 12th and Graduation are eligible for a 25,000.00 Rs. scholarship.

Delhi University Merit Scholarship

- Candidates graduating from DU with a First Division with Honors are eligible for a 25,000.00 Rs. scholarship.

Dr. Sarojini Agarwal Scholarships

- Girls higher Education Initiative: Female candidates who secure 65% or above in 10th, 12th and Graduation are eligible for a 30,000.00 Rs. scholarship.
- Single Mother Scholarship: Candidates raised by a single mother achieving 65% or above in 10th, 12th and Graduation are eligible for a 40,000.00 Rs. scholarship.

Other Scholarships

- Defence/Sports Quota: Wards of Armed Forces, Paramilitary, or Police Services (State & Central) Personnel, as well as students who have achieved state or national level recognition in a reputable sports event, are eligible for a 20,000.00 Rs. Scholarship (Limited to 10 seats per batch).
- *Note : The institution retains the discretion to amend or withdraw the scholarship policy at any time without prior notice. Scholarship amounts shall be applied exclusively to the final installment of the fee*

Important Notes

- a) Only one scholarship category can be availed
- b) Scholarships are adjusted in the last instalment of 2nd year
- c) Valid supporting documents are required

Admission Confirmation

Selected candidates must confirm admission by:

- Paying admission fee
- Submitting required documents
- Completing enrollment formalities

Documents Required

Candidates are required to submit the following documents:

- i. Class X Marksheet
- ii. Class XII Marksheet
- iii. Graduation Marksheet
- iv. Entrance Exam Scorecard
- v. Transfer Certificate / Migration Certificate
- vi. Passport Size Photographs
- vii. ID Proof (Aadhaar Card)
